

Liselotte Engstam is an experienced Chair and Non-Executive Board Director with over 15 years of board leadership across nine publicly listed companies, seven private firms, and five non-profit or foundation organizations. Her background includes international CEO and executive roles in global technology, engineering, and services companies across Europe, the United States, and India.

She currently serves on the boards of the publicly listed company Zalaris, private companies Ografy/ESRI and Digoshen, chairs the Boards Impact Forum in collaboration with the World Economic Forum and the Climate Governance Initiative, and she is a board member of the INSEAD Sweden Alumni Association.

As founder and Chair of the ThinkTank Digoshen, Liselotte drives initiatives that advance academic research, board education, and collaborative learning on modern leadership practices. She is co-author of several acclaimed works, including *Leading a Board – Chairs’ Practices Across Europe*, *AI Leadership for Boards*, and *Dynamic Board Capabilities*, developed in collaboration with INSEAD, the Royal Institute of Technology, and Chalmers University, and hosts the podcast Exploring Leaders by Digoshen.

Liselotte lectures at institutions including INSEAD, and her current research explores how boards can strengthen resilience and oversight in the face of AI disruption, cybersecurity risks, and climate transition. She has been recognized among the top 100 globally in modern corporate governance and she is frequently invited as a keynote speaker and advisor on board-level oversight of AI, transformation, and sustainability.

Alongside her board work, Liselotte is an active Executive Coach, supporting board members and senior leaders in navigating complexity, disruption, and personal leadership growth. Her coaching blends strategic foresight, creative methods, and evidence-based insights, often incorporating reflective tools like scenario exploration and digital art to unlock new perspectives. She works with leaders at the intersection of governance, AI, and sustainability transitions.

She holds a Master of Science in Engineering and Sustainability and is board certified by INSEAD (IDP-C). She is a Fellow of the Harvard Medical School’s Institute of Coaching, a Fellow of the Salzburg Global Corporate Governance Forum, and a member of the European Corporate Governance Institute. She also contributes to INSEAD’s International Directors Network and Mastering Change Global Club and holds certifications in climate risk governance and AI strategy from institutions such as IMD and the Institute for the Future.

Under the artistic name *Novisali*, Liselotte explores human insight, foresight, and transformation through digitally enhanced visual storytelling. Her work is featured in exhibitions and integrated into leadership and coaching settings as a catalyst for reflection and renewal.
